Highlighted Program of the Month:

Veteran Dental Program

Veterans may now be eligible for the Oregon Veteran Dental Program. The Oregon Health Authority and The Oregon Department of Human Services are accepting applications for the new program.

Who qualifies? People who live in Oregon; are not eligible for OHP (Medicaid); are veterans; and have an income at or below 400 percent of the Federal Poverty Level.

Veterans can apply online at ONE.Oregon.gov or download a paper application at OHP.Oregon.gov/. An application can be mailed by calling customer service at 800-699-9075.

Assistance is also available in Union and Baker Counties from Teresa Aguilera, 541-910-0336, at NEON; and Brian Blais, 541-962-8842, through Veterans Services.

LOL (Loads on Laundry) Union County

LOL (Loads of Laundry) is a joint project amongst:

- Community Connection of Northeast Oregon- Senior Center
- Blue Mountain Coin-Op
- La Grande United Methodist Church

Unhoused or homeless individuals or families **can apply by appointment only at Community Connection, 541-963-7532**, 1504 Albany Street in La Grande. If eligible, they can request one laundry voucher a week, for use at Blue Mountain Coin -Op, 717 20th Street, La Grande, near Bi-Mart.

There are only 40 vouchers a week that are available. This is on a first come, first serve basis. The voucher entitles an individual, including individuals within a family, to 1 regular or medium load of wash and 2 or 3 dryer cycles in a large commercial dryer. One packet of soap is provided for each voucher.


Vouchers can be presented on Wednesdays between 10 AM and 2 PM. If a person wants to complete an entire wash cycle and dryer cycle, they need to have their wash started in a machine by 1:15 PM. Be ready to start your laundry when you arrive as space is limited.

Helping Hearts will be hosting guest speaker Rebecca Bender who will be presenting "Not In Our Town" Changing Our Community's Perception on



Human Trafficking. Rebecca is a national trainer, author and survivor.

There will be two opportunities to hear Rebecca. One will be held on **Thursday, April 13, 2023, 10:00am-2:30pm** at the Cloverleaf Hall, 600 NW 1st, Enterprise, Oregon for **professional and service providers.** This training for professionals will present information on how to properly identify and respond to child victims of these abuses.

Rebecca will also be offering a community awareness presentation of "Not in Wallowa County" for students (recommended 7th through 12th grade) and adults to learn to recognize, intervene, and prevent human trafficking in Wallowa County. This community event will be held on Thursday, April 13, 2023 Enterprise High School, Enterprise, Oregon. The event will begin at 5:00 – 5:30pm with a light dinner served in the cafeteria. At 5:30pm, parents can checkin their children for child-friendly activities and supervision in the little gym during event. The presentation will begin at 6:00pm in the gymnasium.
