

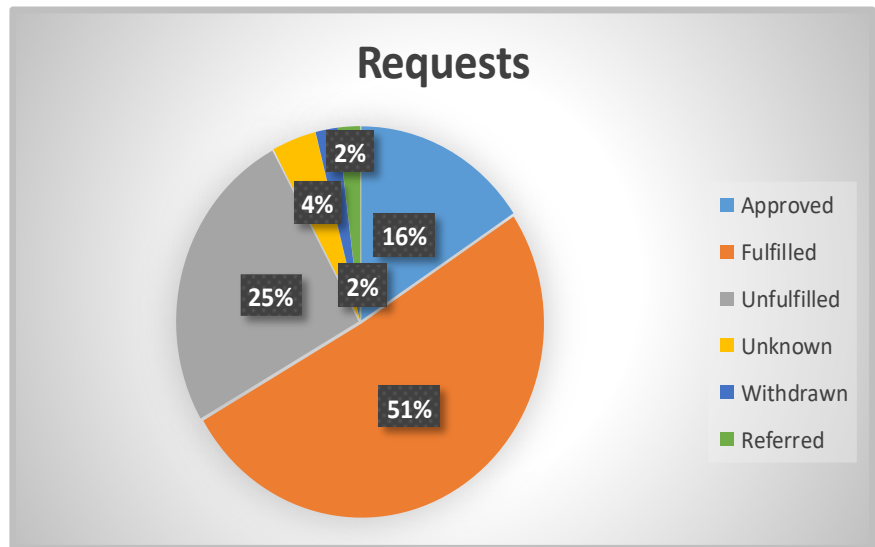


EOCRN Filling Needs in Baker, Union and Wallowa Counties

In the past four months, EOCRN has approved 51 requests. 40 were for needs and 11 were shares.

Currently:

- ◆ 8 are waiting to be filled
- ◆ 26 were fulfilled

- ◆ 3 were withdrawn/unknown/referred
