Requests Recently Filled

65 requests were submitted in the first quarter of 2024. 21% of those requests are still waiting to be filled with 57% filled. Only 16% were reported as unfulfilled.

Furniture and appliances were the most requested items followed by cars/ transportation; medical supplies; sporting equipment; mattresses/bed frames; and personal hygiene. gas, snow boots, queen bed and mattresses, shower chairs, office chair, transportation, vacuums, snowboard and clothing, bike helmet, microwave, gel pad, car seats, refrigerator, couch, recliner, haircut, t-ball equipment, toaster, and soccer shoes.


