Eastern Oregon Community Resource Network currently has 293 members. One hundred and three members have submitted 402 requests to EOCRN. These requests were reported in the following categories:

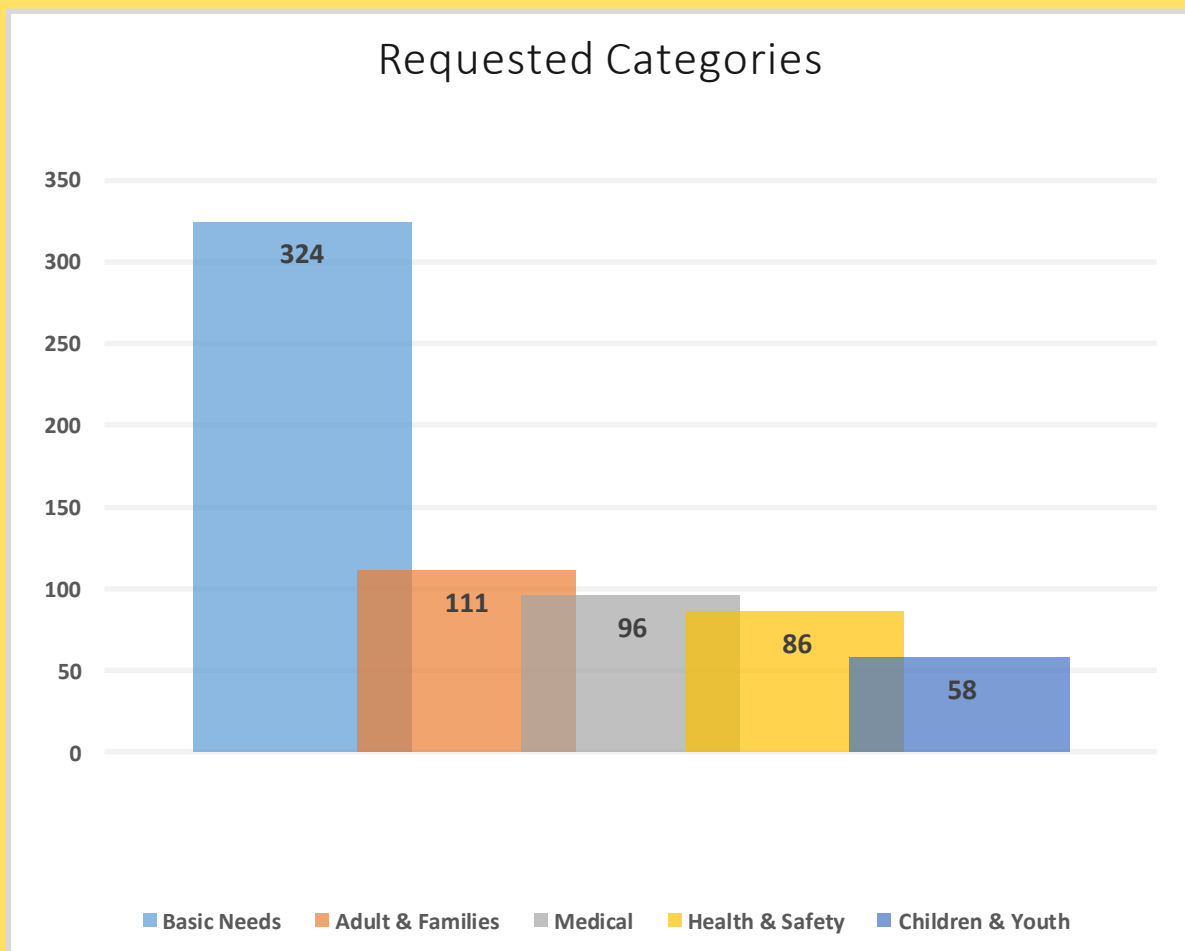

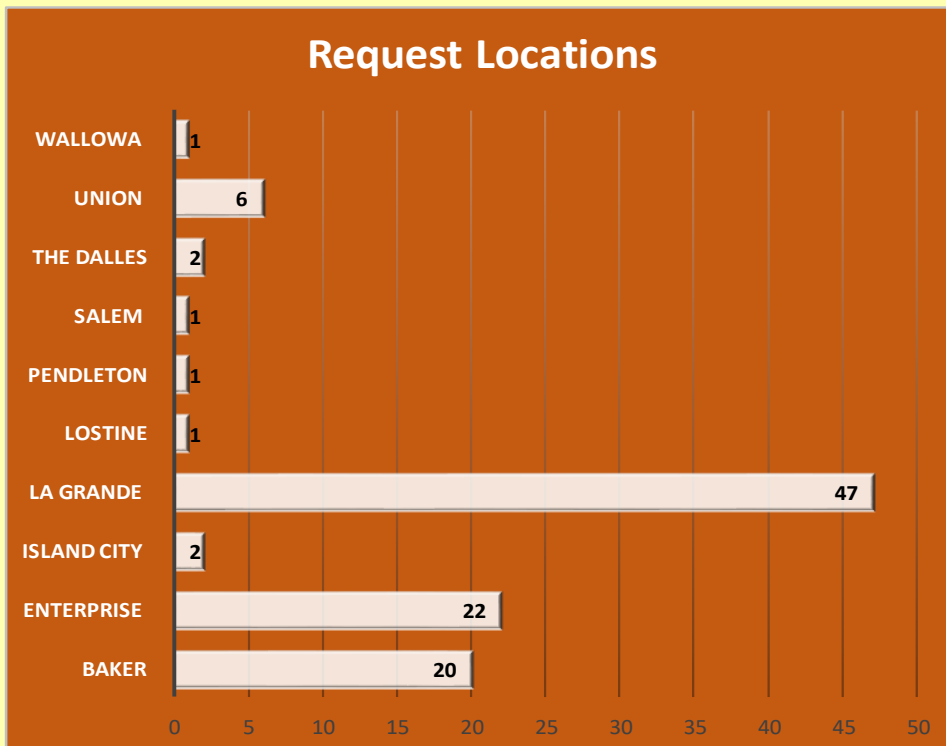
