



Distribution will start at the end of October. The specific dates and times will be announced at a later date. United Methodist Church 1612 Fourth Street La Grande.


THE LA GRANDE LIONS COATS FOR KIDS PROGRAM 2022


WHERE: The United Methodist Church 1612 Fourth St., La Grande
