Last Quarter at a Glance: July-September 2023

58 requests were submitted in the last quarter. 26 (44%) of the requests were fulfilled. Twenty requests (34%) were approved and await to be filled. Out of the 58 requests, only 5 (8%) have been reported as unfulfilled. Seven requests have been deleted, referred, withdrawn or status unknown.

The location of clients and requests totaled 40 from Union County;



11 Baker County, and 7 Wallowa County.

Fifty-one of the

requests were for needs and 7 were shares of resources and information. Forty -eight percent of the requests involved children and 3% were for pet needs.


