IMESD EI/ECSE Community Spotlight

At the IMESD EI/ECSE program (InterMountain Service District Early Intervention/Early Childhood Special Education), we get the privilege of serving children with unique and special needs ages birth to 5 across Baker, Grant, Morrow, Umatilla, Union, and Wallowa counties. We not only support children in growth and development but have the opportunity to support parents, caregivers, guardians, and Resource Parents. We have an incredible team of teachers and specialists who are caring, compassionate, and skilled in their area of expertise. Children are served in various environments such as classrooms, homes, and childcare/preschool settings.

Children may qualify for services in areas of cognitive, adaptive, fine & gross motor, and communication. Children who qualify will receive services weekly in most cases depending on the needs of the child. Services may include special instruction, speech & language, physical therapy, occupational therapy, autism services, and more.
